6. Conservation Action Underway

Active conservation of Curlew has begun in 2013. The actions that are being undertaken include:

- 1. Locating Curlew nests and cooperation with farmers, who avoid Curlew nests during agricultural operations (rolling, fertilising, under-sowing, meadow mowing).
- 2. Artificial incubation of eggs, real eggs replaced with wooden egg dummies.
- 3. Cooperation with hunters, Red Fox numbers reduction in Curlew breeding sites
- 4. Farmers and youth education:
- publishing of education materials (pamphlets, calendars, posters, comic strips, t-shirts)
- workshops for farmers (promoting agri-environmental subsidies)
- lectures in rural schools
- placing educational boards in Curlew breeding sites
- 5. Active participation in the process of creating project assumptions for "birds" option in National Agri-Environmental Programe for 2014-2020. Introducing solutions favorable for waders (date of the first swath no sooner than 15 June, no later than 10 July.
